The Modern Day Back Alley Abortionists

Please Take One Minute to Google: [Live Action Petition](#) to File Your Opposition to: Walgreens, CVS and Rite Aid—The Modern Day Back Alley Abortionists. In the year just prior to Roe v Wade there were just 39 (according to the CDC) deaths of women due to "Back Alley Abortions". Yet Roe v. Wade was enacted to protect the life of mothers from the death resulting from "Back Alley Abortions". Walgreens, CVS and Rite Aid have decided to dispense Mifepristone as part 1 of a 2-drug protocol to produce at home abortions. Already there have been two dozen deaths from women taking Mifepristone to produce an abortion. Hundreds of other women have incurred health issues from taking it. With an increased use of Mifepristone the number of deaths will obviously increase beyond these numbers. An increase in injuries to women's health can also be expected. There will be further background information on the dangers and harms of these non-prescription abortion drugs at the Live Action website. Even if you have signed the petition before, please sign again. We need to keep the pressure on these companies until they realize that dispensing non-prescription drugs, often to the unwary, unprepared and uneducated and underage, that this is not "health care" for the child nor the women, not health care that we expect from our neighborhood family pharmacies. At the website you may be asked to also donate to Live Action. You do not need to donate. Your petition will go through whether you do or don't.

Further Background Supporting the Petition Drive against Walgreens, CVS and Rite Aid Pharmacies. The Abortion Pill kills babies and kills or injures women. It is not Health Care (Article excerpted From Life News). Earlier this year, the Biden administration's Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued an alarming rule change to allow dangerous life-ending chemical abortion drugs to be ordered online or purchased in a retail pharmacy without ever seeing a doctor in person, turning brick-and-mortar pharmacies and post offices into abortion centers. This reckless policy is the latest in a long line of decisions by the FDA that have put the profits of abortion industry over both federal law and the health and safety of mothers and babies who are directly threatened by chemical abortion drugs.

On Nov. 18, 2022, four national medical associations and four doctors, who care for pregnant and post-abortive women, sued the FDA for its decisions to approve and subsequently deregulate chemical abortion drugs. Since the FDA first approved mifepristone in 2000—the first of a two-drug regimen to cause chemical abortions, we now know even more about the harms these drugs cause to women and girls, and their unborn babies. ...Despite weak reporting requirements, we know of at least 28 deaths of pregnant women and more than 500 life-threatening complications associated with mifepristone—on top of thousands of serious adverse events. Chemical abortions are four times more dangerous to the mother than surgical abortions and can cause serious complications. Compared to surgical abortions, women who use chemical abortion drugs are 50 percent more likely to require emergency care within 30 days of use.

The FDA also failed to comply with its obligations under federal law to study the impact of the drugs on adolescent girls and failed to prove their safety under the labeled conditions... Under the FDA's new tele-abortion protocols, pregnant women are denied chance to be first clinically screened in-person by a doctor to rule out potentially life-threatening contraindications like an ectopic pregnancy or to accurately determine the age of the baby.

ILLINOIS PUSHES FOR MORE ABORTIONS

Abortion Industry Uses Illinois as an "Abortion Island"

While many Midwestern states protect life and mothers from abortion, Illinois **allows abortion through 9 months of pregnancy and minor girls can have abortions without their parents ever knowing.**

In January, Illinois passed even more extreme laws that:

- Bring more doctors to Illinois to perform abortions – ***even if they lost their medical license in another state for performing illegal abortion.***
- Allows ***non-physicians to perform surgical abortions*** if they do not use general anesthesia and
- Allows birth centers to perform abortions.

Because of Illinois' extreme laws, more abortion clinics are coming – including in Champaign – just 8 minutes from the U of I campus.

The owner of the Champaign clinic works at a clinic that **lost its license**, then after opening under a new name **performed an abortion on a woman who was unable to consent because of drug use.**

State laws matter more than ever. That is why the March for Life Chicago is moving to the Illinois state capitol, Springfield.

Join us in standing against these extreme laws at the Illinois March for Life on March 21st."
